- 2 All Purchasers must pre-register prior to the sale with their name, address and contact telephone number. This can be done either by email to d.thompson@sunderlands.co.uk or telephone David Thompson on 07836 595950.
- 3 **Bidding / Commission Bids** - the highest bidder to be the Purchaser and no bidding shall be retracted after the hammer has fallen. The Auctioneer reserves the right to refuse any bidding and in the event of any dispute the Lot may be sold again at the Auctioneer's discretion. In the event any Purchaser does not wish to attend the sale for any reason the Auctioneers are prepared to accept pre-sale auction commission bids. A pro-forma is attached to these Particulars. if you wish to take advantage of such an arrangement your clear instructions should be set out on the Commission Bid Form. It must be received by the Auctioneer, David A Thompson, no later than 4.00pm on the day of the sale either by email to d.thompson@sunderlands.co.uk or telephone 07836 595950 or delivered by hand or post to the Auctioneers offices at Offa Street, St Peters Square, Hereford, HR1 2PQ by no later than 4.00pm on the day of sale or hand it to the auctioneer / clerk in the Farmyard by 6.00pm on Wednesday 8th July. It is the Purchaser's responsibility to ensure those instructions are delivered. We can accept no liability for any late or delayed requests or instructions. The Auctioneer will endeavour to bid for the Lot(s) selected up to a maximum of the price stated for each individual Lot or Lots.
- 4 **Reserves** - All Lots are put up for sale subject to any reserve price imposed by the Vendor.
- 5 **Order of Sale** - The right is reserved to make any alterations or withdrawals if so requested by the Vendor.
- 6 **Liability of the Purchaser** - Each Lot is offered as seen and any intending Purchaser must satisfy themselves as to each Lot. In the event of loss or destruction by fire prior to the completion of combining of each Lot, the Purchaser shall be entitled to a refund of the appropriate proportion of the purchase price, but on completion of the combining the straw is the responsibility of the Purchaser who shall indemnify the Vendor for any damage caused to the property in the course of the removal of any Lot.
- 7 **Combining** - The straw, as far as is reasonably practical in the circumstances of each Lot, will be cut to a height of not more than 6" from ground level.
- 8 **Removal** - Clearance within ten to fourteen days of combining of each Lot.
- 9 **Payment** - All Lots are sold for cash and are due for immediate settlement on date of invoice.
- 10 **Viewing** - The Lots may be viewed at any reasonable time without prior appointment.
- 11 **Black grass** - The Purchasers or their Contractors may only enter the farm with clean balers and equipment at the specific request of the Vendor to avoid spreading black grass or other noxious weeds. Your cooperation in this matter will be much appreciated.
- 12 The sale is subject to any restrictions or obligations that may be in force by HM Government in respect of the Coronavirus 19 pandemic.

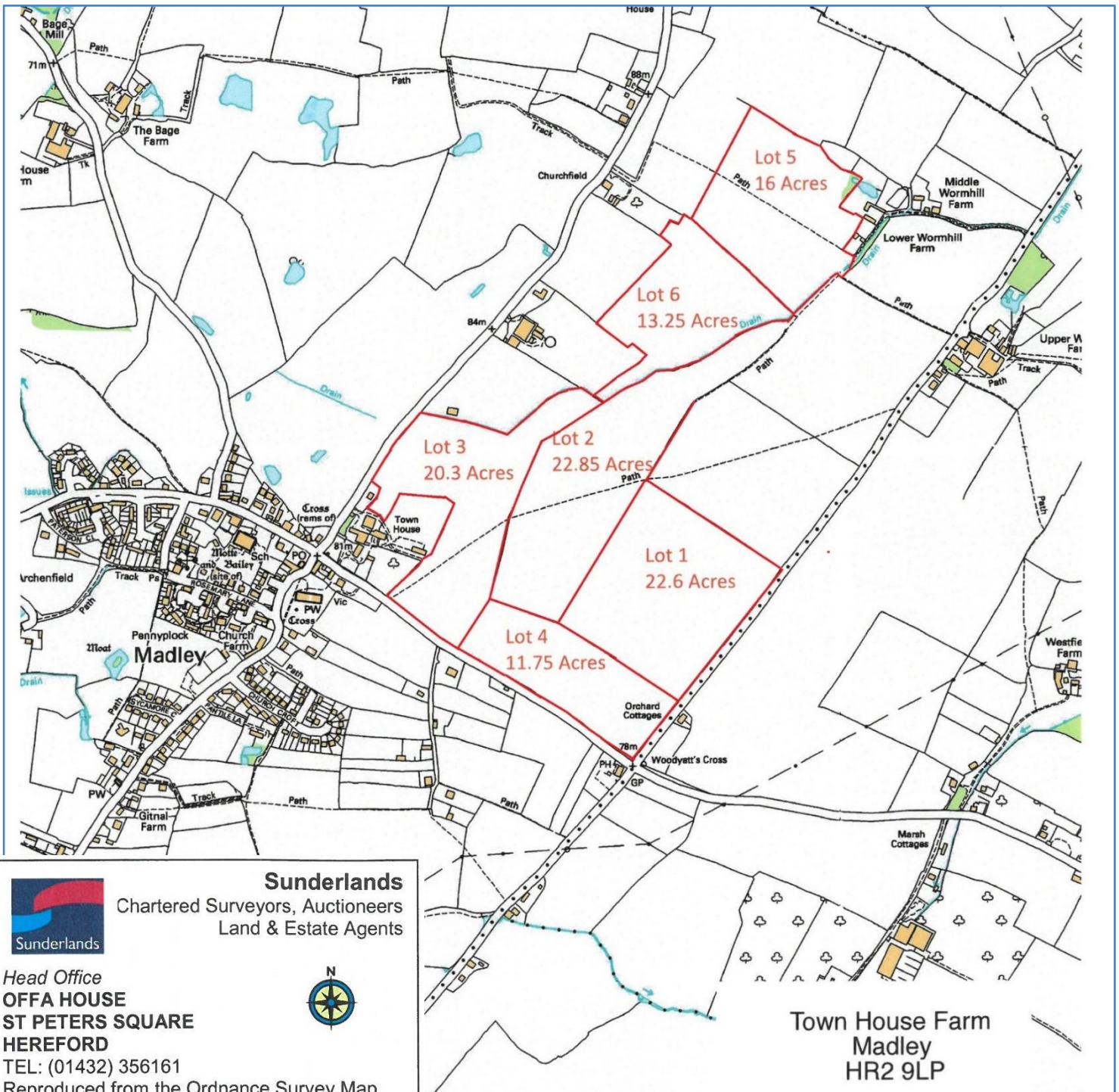
